A graphene oxide (GO)-modified Ag-nanoparticle (AgNPs) was synthesized by a simple two-step method. The resulting GO-AgNPs showed highly electrocatalytic activity toward the oxidation of dopamine (DA) in 0.1 M NaOH solution. The electrocatalytic activity of the GO-AgNPs toward the oxidation of DA was 3.3 times greater than that of the AgNPs and the peak currents of DA were linearly increased with the increasing concentrations of DA in the range of 0.5 μ M-20 mM with a detection limit of 0.04 μ M (S/N = 3) for the proposed GO-AgNPs based electrochemical sensor. A possible electrochemical reaction mechanism was also discussed in detail.
